



Payments Schedule

\$700 per year per person \$1200 per year per couple \$500 pensioner

Payment schedule: Deposit \$100 due 1st February 2017.

Balance due: February 28th 2017 for the first year only.

For those paying off the course: Deposit \$100 plus weekly payments of \$20 per week commencing 14th of February 2017..

Special consideration will be given to those unable to afford the upfront deposit and may pay off the course at \$20 per week commencing on the 14th of February 2017. **For those with the means:** It would be greatly appreciated if you could settle the entire account by the due date so we can pay for the course from the suppliers and printing costs.

Refunds of course fees: For those who do not wish to continue with the course the first \$100 is non-refundable. There are 4 terms a year - If a student not wishing to continue does not notify the college in writing prior to the completion of the previous term then another \$100 is also non-refundable for the following term. ie. Once a term has commenced that term must be paid for regardless if only one week of that term has been completed. This also applies to those paying off the course.

Stationary and Text Book Requirements

Course notes are provided in bound volumes for each module so very little other stationary or text books are required.

Stationary requirements:

Pen, pencil, rubber, whiteout and A4 note book (hardcover preferred)

Text book requirements:

Bible – Old King James, New King James or New International Versions are preferred but not absolutely necessary (Good News version cannot be used, Living or Amplified versions are useful as a backup but not as first preference) – see Pastor Paul if you are unsure your bible version is suitable.

Text book options:

Concordance - not necessary but very helpful for study.

(This first on the list for those wanting to purchase extra texts)

Bible handbook – great for historical facts and scripture explanation and context. (Hayley's is great)

Greek / Hebrew Dictionary – useful for those wanting deeper levels of study

Internet access: <http://www.biblegateway.com/> a free useful resource, includes keyword search and passage lookup and cross references many different versions of the bible.

Laptop or tablets can be used in class and wireless internet access will be provided if required.
